Anna Kathryn "Kay" Danner Routzahn, 87, of Connersville, died at 9:15 P.M., Monday, July 28, 2003 at Lincoln Center East where she had been a resident since May 17, 2003. She had been in failing health for the past three months.

She was born March 31, 1916 in Madison, IN., one of four children of Roy S. and Anna M. Tower Danner. A graduate of Madison High School, she attended Hanover College receiving her teacher certificate and later attended Indiana University. For two years, she taught third grade at Alexandria, Indiana.
